Learners talked to some veterans who now work at the museum about the war.

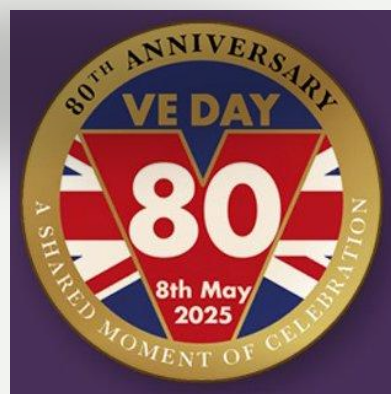

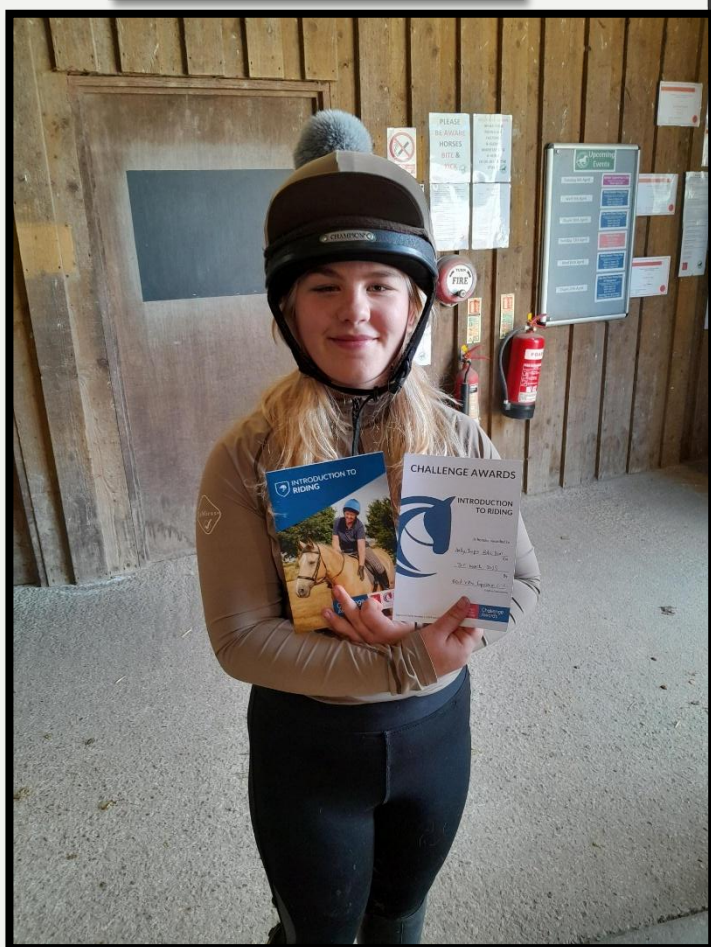
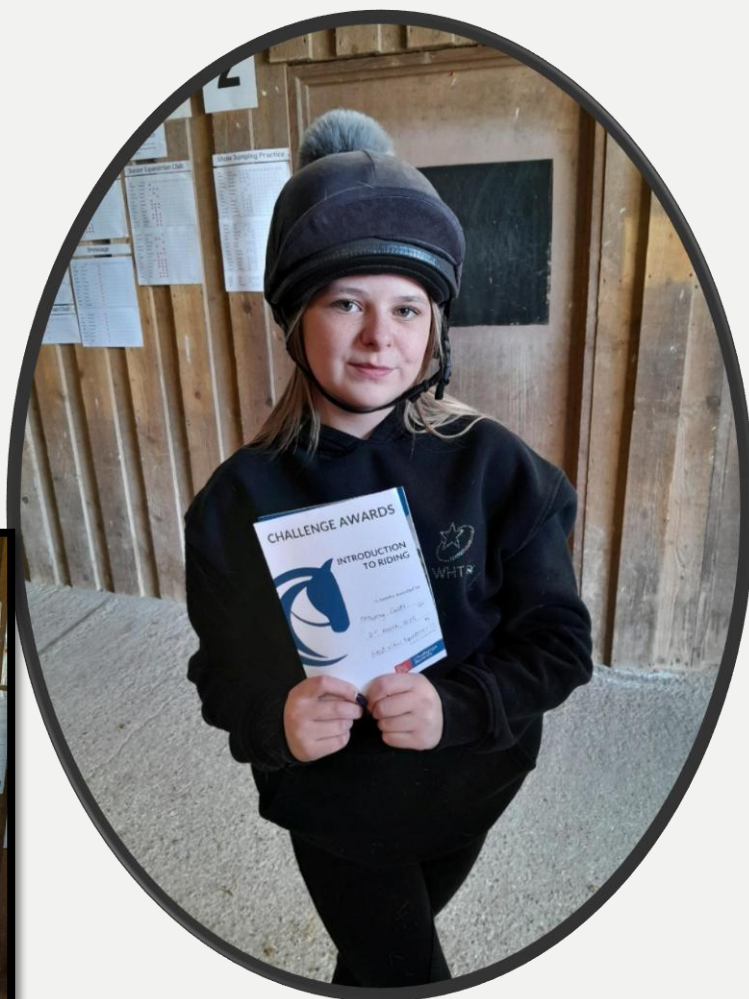




Equine Therapy And Challenge Awards

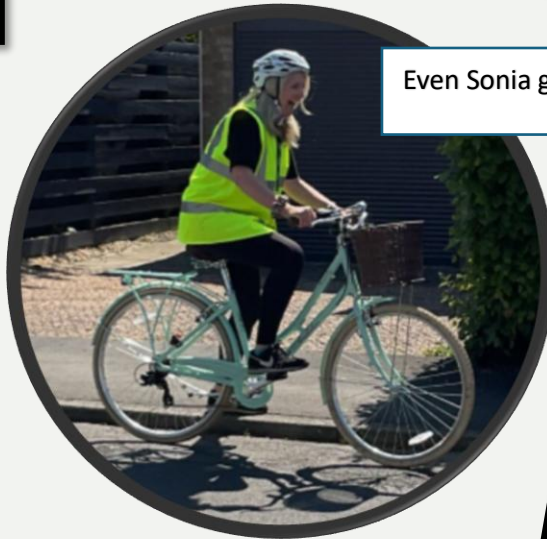
Bikeability Level 2 – 20th / 21st May 2025
